He said to them in reply, 'Do you think because these Galileans suffered in this way they were greater sinners than all other Galileans? By no means, but I tell you, if you do not repent, you will perish as they did. Or those eighteen people who were killed when the tower of Shiloam fell on them, do you think they were more guilty than everyone else who lived in Jerusalem? By no means. But I tell you, if you do not repent, you will perish as they did.' "

» People of GOD, beloved ones of GOD, <u>I double</u> repeat this JESUS' message so that you and me, we do not take JESUS for granted. I quote our Saviour's word again:
